- Excellent communication skills and the ability to establish rapport with children with a diverse range of needs.
- Reliable and trustworthy individual who is committed to providing quality, person centred care.
- Be well presented and have a kind and caring nature.
- Be calm, polite, and professional while maintaining the highest level of confidentiality.
- The ability to work autonomously and collaboratively within a team.
- Fluency in English (verbal)
- Satisfactory Garda Vetting and reference checks.
