What is a companion card?

- A companion card is for people with a disability who need the assistance of another person in order to access the Leisure Centre.
- A companion card simply ensures that people with a disability who need assistance of another person to access the leisure centre facilities are not charged two admission fees.

Who is it for?

- Any person with a disability who needs the assistance of another person to access the leisure centre can apply for a companion card
- You will need to provide proof of your eligibility i.e. statement of current disability payment, doctors letter etc

How do I apply for a companion card?

- Application forms are available from reception at Monaghan Leisure Centre
- If you need help to fill in the application form a member of staff at the leisure centre will help you
- A member of staff at the leisure centre will explain the terms and conditions of the companion card.
- Completed forms should be returned in person to Monaghan Leisure Centre-

You will need to bring

1. Completed form
2. A clear passport sized photograph
3. Proof of eligibility (this will be verified by a member of staff and returned to you there and then)

How do I use my companion card?

- When your application is processed and you are eligible you will be given a companion card.
- All you have to do is bring this card with when accessing the leisure centre and your companion will not be charged an admission fee.
